

## **CURATOR OF ARCHAEOLOGY**

**The Prehistoric Museum, affiliated with Utah State University – College of Eastern Utah, seeks a full time Curator of Archaeology. The Curator is responsible for oversight, curation and conservation of the archaeological collections at the Prehistoric Museum. The Curator will also oversee and supervise field and laboratory investigations of cultural resources and sites. The Curator may be required to teach archaeology in class or field school.**

**Responsibilities include supervision of staff, volunteers and students in that department; conduct field and laboratory investigations of cultural resources and sites primarily, but not necessarily exclusively, in eastern Utah (requires securing necessary permits for field investigations); oversee curation and conservation of the archaeological collections of the museum; provide text for exhibits and consultation on exhibit design; provide educational programs at the museum relative to archaeology and the cultural resources and collections; insure compliance with NAGPRA regulations**

**Minimum qualifications: Ph.D. in Archaeology, with prior field and laboratory experience; attention to detail; excellent written and verbal communication skills.**

**Preferred qualifications: original research with a focus on the archaeology of Utah-western Colorado (preference is for research in the Museum's mission area: eastern Utah); familiarity with pertinent state and federal regulations, including steps for NAGPRA compliance.**
